Application for Senior Citizen Exemption of Water Utility Services

Seniors (age 62 and older) residing in the city limits of the City of Raymondville may qualify for an exemption to the minimum monthly charge for secondary water meter services only on a residential account which is a homestead exemption or current lease is held in their name. This exemption shall be in an amount established annually by ordinance of the City of Raymondville Council.

The City of Raymondville shall grant the senior exemption to the minimum monthly base meter charge to any senior residing in the city limits of the City of Raymondville, upon submission of valid proof that he/she has reached their 62nd birthday, on a residential account held in their name of the senior for real property for which such individual has a current homestead exemption or current lease held in his/her name. **The valid proof of age and lease document (if tax records are not in the name of the senior) must be filled and submitted in person to the utilities Department located at Raymondville City Hall during regular working hours.** This exemption shall take effect at the beginning of the next available billing cycle following the submission and approval of the application to the Water Utility Department.

****Please note: you and/or your spouse may only receive one senior homestead discount****
